## **Course Outline**

## Day 1 - Planning, Patient & Placement

Covers core principles for implant planning and placement, including patient selection, medical/dental factors, atraumatic extraction, socket preservation (hands-on with Ossix products), implant selection, digital planning, CBCT markers, and software navigation.

**Hands-on:** Sidexis/Sicat navigation, socket preservation models, suturing for closure and grafting.

## Day 2 – Patient Cases, Guides & Implant Kits

Focuses on case-based planning, guided placement, immediate placement/temporization, guide design and use, solutions for complex cases, transmucosal elements, anterior implant planning, and surgical kit components.

**Hands-on:** Sicat planning, surgical guide design (Cerec Guide 3), Astra EV guided surgery on models, 3D model guided placement, custom healing abutment techniques.

The Chief Clinical Officer at Passion Dental Group, this clinician is a leader in digital dentistry and implantology.

With a DMD from the University of Saskatchewan and an OMFS Fellowship from Albert Einstein College of Medicine,
