



This clinically focused course walks through the complete indirect restorative workflow in the digital age—from preparation and scanning to design, materials, and cementation. Participants will explore how to integrate digital impressions, communicate effectively with digital labs, and leverage chairside design for same-day crowns where appropriate. Practical guidelines for preparation parameters, core build-ups, and restoring endodontically treated teeth will be emphasized, along with a clear review of material selection and cementation protocols to maximize longevity and predictability.
